Miasmatic Indications in Client and Family

⇒ **Syilitic**

- Suicidal depression, grandparent

⇒ **Cancer**

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⇒ **Tubercular**

- Eczema, asthma, allergies, dad and siblings
- Recurring strept infections, dad and grandparent
- Hyperthyroid, grandparent

⇒ **Sycotic**

- Ganglion cyst, self and sibling
- Warts, self and mom
- Excessive pot use, self
- Fibrocystic breasts, self
- Heavy menses, self
- Varicose veins, mom
- Hemorrhoids, mom and grandparent
- Endometriosis, mom
- Nasal polyps, grandparent

⇒ **Psoric**

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Chief Complaints & Observations

⇒ **Fibrocystic breasts**

- Onset: age 35
- Etiology: unknown
- Endogenous OR Exogenous:
 - Iatrogenic (exogenous) from synthetic hormones, birth control and IVF
 - Inheritance (endogenous) – sycotic miasm, Med
- Nature: Both breasts have hard, lumpy areas, but left is worse, tender just before menstrual flow, they get very tender
- Modalities:
 - Better:
 - Worse: before menses
- Concomitants: PMS mood swings
- Frequency: constant but worse with PMS
- Intensity: pain level normally 3/10, before cycle 8/10
- Classification of Disease: Iatrogenic, acute miasmatic, inheritance
- Chronic Miasm/Nosode: Med
- Intercurrent: Carb-an or Hep
- Current state: she's not too bothered by them except before her cycle, she did not improve on the remedies and she became irritable and hurried

⇒ **My Observations**

- I feel like I'm not getting the whole story from her, like she's hiding something, otherwise friendly
- She is a little overweight, otherwise average size
